Student Conferenceship Awards

The Annual Computer Security Applications Conference (ACSAC) is an internationally recognized forum where students can meet with practitioners, researchers, and developers in information and system security to learn and to exchange practical ideas and experiences.

The Applied Computer Security Associates (ACSA) is pleased to announce the availability of Student Conferenceships enabling qualified students to attend the conference. The goal of a conferenceship is to support students who would not normally be able to attend the conference. Although merit is one of the factors considered, students should not view a conferenceship as a pure merit award. In particular, students are encouraged to pursue other sponsorship. Our goal is to enable the largest number possible of students to attend ACSAC, which will only be possible with the collaboration of the students in requesting a conferenceship only for those items that cannot be funded by other sources.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Conferenceships can be requested by full-time undergraduate or graduate students at an accredited university or school and will be awarded to students that will get the most from ACSAC. We especially encourage members of underrepresented groups, including women, minorities, and persons with disabilities, to take advantage of and apply for Student Conferenceship awards. Conferenceship awards will normally take the form of a reimbursement to be applied against conference registration and travel/lodging expenses. Our intent is to help as many students as possible based on need.

To be considered for a Student Conferenceship, students must submit a conferenceship application, a current CV, a short essay describing their interest and background in information security, and a letter of recommendation from a faculty member confirming that the student is in good standing plus a justification of financial need.
