The CPS Principal Investigator Meeting provides a forum for a wide range of stakeholders in academia, industry and federal agencies to review new developments in CPS foundations, to identify new, emerging applications, and to discuss technology gaps and barriers. The program of the meeting includes presentations about projects funded by NSF and other agencies, panels and discussion groups.

Abstracts will now be collected for CD distribution. Talks, posters, and abstracts should convey the overall research objectives and scientific directions of the project. Abstracts (not to exceed one page) should be submitted **publication-ready** to CPS-PI-Meeting@cps-vo.org by **Tuesday, 15 July 2010**. Please include the following in the subject line of your message: "Abstract – CPS PI Meeting.". A **Microsoft Word attachment is the preferred method**. ORAL PRESENTATIONS

A subset of the projects will be selected for oral presentations. Oral presentations are scheduled to be 15-20 minutes in length. Each session will be concluded with a moderated panel, in which presenters will participate. It is expected that all presentations will be from computers and use an LCD projector which will be available.
