Description

- Brought together stakeholders from academia, industry, nonprofits, international partners, municipal governments, and underserved communities (e.g., First Nations tribes)
- Goal: Develop a socio-technical research agenda for enhancing well-being in diverse communities through smart technologies
- Prepared a report outlining five- and ten-year roadmaps for realizing S&CC vision



Findings

- S&CC vision requires solving cross-cutting global challenges, while still understanding constraints of local communities
- Coordinated effort at multiple scales among industry partners, municipal, regional, and national governments, academic researchers, nonprofit organizations, and community groups is needed
